“The Kroehn Music Scholarships”
2022

Colin Kroehn was a respected Barossa Vigneron who tended his famous vines in Eden Valley until his passing in 2010. A generous bequest from his estate led to the establishment of a music scholarship at the College. The purpose of the scholarship is to provide financial support to enable a student to access private music tuition.

Each year the College makes available two scholarships. The value of each scholarship is \$2000, paid at \$400 per year for each year the student continues to study music (Year 7 through 12).

Eligibility of Scholarship

The music Scholarship is open to all students enrolled in any Year level at Faith who can demonstrate their interest and commitment to musical instruments such as:

- Strings Violin, Viola, Cello
- Woodwind Flute, Oboe, Clarinet, Bassoon
- Brass Trumpet, Trombone, French Horn, Tuba
- Percussion (Tuned and Untuned combination compulsory)
- Voice Classical or Theatrical
- Other instruments or voice styles may also be considered.

Conditions of Scholarship

Holders of Scholarships will be required to:

- Study Music as an elective subject at Faith and show long term commitment
- be a member of a school band, as applicable, attending all rehearsals and performances
- undertake regular tuition on their instrument either at Faith or with a suitable instrumental teacher elsewhere

Scholarship information

- holders of Scholarships will receive a payment of \$400.00 per year for each year they remain a music student
- two scholarships will be awarded each year based on musical merit as determined by the Principal and the Music Learning Area Coordinator
- Faith Lutheran College reserves the right not to award a scholarship if suitable candidates are not found
- no student is eligible to receive a scholarship more than once
- students are eligible to apply again the following year if they are unsuccessful in gaining a scholarship



How to apply

There are 4 items that need to be submitted to complete this application:

1. A brief written recommendation from either their current school Principal or music teacher supporting the application
2. A recent school report
3. Application form
4. MP4, AVI or MOV video file (instructions below)

Video instructions

1. Please submit with the application a video of the applicant featuring **one piece** on their principal instrument.
2. The audition piece should be between 2- 3 minutes.
3. Any genre (style) or piece of music is suitable provided it best represents the applicant's musicianship and skill level.

Assessment Process

On receipt of all applications, a shortlist of candidates will be prepared and provided to the Music Learning Area Coordinator and the Principal.

Applicants will need to be available for a final brief interview with either the Principal or the Music Learning Area Coordinator, if required.

All applicants will be advised of the outcome of their application by the end of November.
